

LOUISA KRICK EXPIRED TODAY

Aged Resident Of Union Township Dies of Complications of Diseases

Louisa Kirck (sic), 80, died at her home in Union Township, near the Clarks Chapel Church at 3:10 o'clock this morning, following an illness of complications. Mrs. Kirck (sic) was well known in the Clarks Chapel neighborhood having resided there for the last sixty years.
