

# WILL OF HERMAN

## BUETTNER WAS PROBATED.

DECATUR, Ind., Dec. 18.—The will of Herman Buettner, late of Union township, who died recently after an operation for gall stones, was probated. The will was executed November 11, last, a short time before he was operated upon and was witnessed by D. E. Smith and John Schurger. He gives on-third of the real estate and five hundred dollars to his wife, Alice, and the remaining real and personal property, including forty acres of land in Union township, he gives to his son Charles, who is to pay the following amounts, with three per cent. interest after the first year, to the other children: Elizabeth Bieberich, \$200 in two years; Ida Van Buskirk, \$200 in three years; Marie Zaugg, \$200 in four years; Lonnie Buettner, \$200 in five years. Maria Goldner is named executrix.
