

ADELA THIEME DIES SUNDAY AT AGE 69

Mrs. Adela Thieme, 69, of route 3, a lifelong resident of Adams county, died at 7:45 a.m. Sunday at the Lutheran Home, Fort Wayne, where she had been a patient for the past six and one-half years. She had been in ill health for many years.

Mrs. Thieme was born on August 3, 1905, in Root township, the daughter of August and Christine Holle-Bohnke, and was married on December 30, 1923, to Fred Thieme, who survives. They had observed their golden wedding anniversary last year.
