

LOUISE D. THIEME

A route 5 resident, Louise D. Thieme, 79, was dead on arrival at Adams County Memorial Hospital at 2:05 p.m. Thursday after being stricken unexpectedly at home. She was born in Allen County on October 26, 1904 to Fred and Emma Meyer Boenker and married Max F. Thieme on Feb. 14, 1926. He died on January 23, 1983, after almost 57 years of marriage. She was a housewife and a member of the Immanuel Lutheran church and its Ladies Aid.
