

NATHAN GAUSE RITES THURSDAY AFTERNOON

Former Decatur Man Is Taken By Death

Funeral service will be held Thursday for Nathan Gause, 75, of near Columbia City, a former resident of Decatur, who died Sunday afternoon at a nursing home in Warsaw after a five years illness of carcinoma. Services will be held at the Money-Hollingsworth Funeral Home in Columbia City at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, and the body will then be brought to the Salem Cemetery for burial. Brief graveside services will be held at 4:30 p.m.
