

Mary Bell Largent Dies This Morning Funeral Services Monday Afternoon

Mary Bell Largent, 55, a resident of Decatur most of her life, died at 2 o'clock this morning at her home, 721 North Eleventh street, following an illness of two weeks of a heart ailment.
