

Letitia A. Schnepf Dies This Morning  
Funeral Services To Be Wednesday

Mrs. Letitia A. Schnepf, 86, lifelong resident of Union township, died at 6 o'clock this morning at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been ill for two years and critical the past two days.

She was born in Union township Feb. 4, 1869, a daughter of Henderson and Emily Harrison-Walters, and was married to Solomon M. Schnepf Dec. 18, 1890. Mr. Schnepf preceded her in death Dec. 11, 1909.

Mrs. Schnepf was a member of the Union Chapel Evangelical United Brethren church.

Surviving are six sons, Oliver and Floyd Schnepf, at home.
