EARL TUMBLESON DIES AT HOSPITAL

Earl S. "Beck" Tumbleson, 85, of route 1, Monroe, a former resident of Bobo, died at 6:15 p.m. Sunday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital, where he had been a patient two days.

He was a member of the Mt. Tabor Methodist Church in Bobo.

Born in Huntington County on January 7, 1889, he was the son of Washington G. and Adeline Myers-Tumbleson, and was married on Dec. 21, 1924 to Goldie Helm, who died August 2, 1969.

He retired from the Central Soya Co. in 1960 after 19 years of service.

Survivors include one daughter, Mrs. Richard (Betty) Shaffer of route 1, Monroe; one sister, Mrs. Ethel Hawk of Leipsic, O.; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. One son preceded him in death.
