JUNE ANDREWS DIES HERE EARLY THIS MORNING

Funeral Services Will Be Held Thursday Afternoon at Yager Home

Mrs. June Andrews, 39, well known woman of Jefferson township who worked in local factories for several years, passed away at the Hossman hospital this morning at 5:30 o'clock. She was critically ill since Sunday morning but was known to have been ailing in health for several years. Death was attributed to leakage of the heart, aggravated by complications.

The deceased was born in Jefferson township June 23, 1898 - the daughter of Scott and Minerva Burdg McDaniel. Her married to Dewey Andrews was an event of March 19, 1918.

Surviving are a son, Warren Leonard, age 16, two brothers, Roy of Monroe and Dick of Oakland, Calif. Four nieces, two great nieces and two nephews also survive.

She was a member of the Mt. Hope church and had resided with her father in Jefferson township all her life.

Funeral services will be held Thursday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock at the L. L. Yager home with the Rev. Spurgeon Hendrix, pastor of the Mt. Hope church, officiating. He will be assisted in the final rites by the Rev. Pierce. Interment will be made in the Crawford cemetery.
