ROBERT BARR OF GENEVA DIES

85-Year-Old Man Dies At County Infirmary Today

Robert Samuel Barr, 85, a native and resident of Geneva for many years, died this morning at 8:30 o'clock at the Adams county infirmary where he had been an inmate for some time. Death was caused by infirmities.

The deceased was born in Delaware county September 16, 1861, the son of John and Anna Robertson Barr. He lived in Geneva many years and was employed as a timber cutter. He was never married.

Surviving is a brother, James Barr, Geneva justice of the peace.

The body was returned to the Hardy and Hardy Funeral Home at Geneva where funeral services will be held Wednesday afternoon at 2 o'clock, the Rev. J. H. Richardson officiating. Burial will be in Crawford cemetery southeast of Berne.
