Leon McClain, 73, Monroe, died at 8:45 a.m. Monday, March 22, in Adams County Memorial Hospital, Decatur. He was born April 17, 1919, in Delaware County, to Gale and Flossie (Bouse) McClain. He married Lola Baumgartner on Sept. 21, 1947. She survives.
