MRS. McDANIEL RITES TODAY

Mrs. Scott McDaniel Dies Tuesday Afternoon

Mrs. Scott (Minerva Isabell) McDaniel, aged 74, died at her home five miles east and one-half mile south of Berne Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock from lobar pneumonia. She became seriously ill last Friday afternoon and was bedfast until death.

The deceased was born in Blue Creek township May 12, 1863, the daughter of Joseph and Mary Galloway Burdg. She was a resident of the county throughout her life.

July 1, 1883 the wedding to Mr. McDaniel took place near Berne. The couple celebrated their golden wedding anniversary 4 years ago with an event staged at the home.

Surviving are the husband, who has been critically ill and not expected to live for a time, but who was reported to have risen from his sick bed last Sunday for the first time in many weeks; three children, Roy of Monroe, Dick of Oakland City, Calif., and June at home. Seven grandchildren and two great-granddaughters also survive.

Mrs. McDaniel was the last of a family of ten children, five of whom lived for some time.

Funeral services were conducted at the home this afternoon at 1:00 o'clock (C.S.T.) with Rev. Frank Johnson, Rev. John Parr and Rev. Spurgeon Hendrix, officiating. Burial in the Crawford cemetery.
