THE HENRY PASSON WILL ADMITTED TO PROBATE

DECATUR, Ind., Sept. 15 - The will of Henry Passon, the aged farmer, late of Jefferson township, who died Sept. 3 was admitted to probate in the Adams circuit court this afternoon. The will was written July 8, 1908 and was witnessed by W. P. Lloyd Poll Chek and John H. Passon. He provides first that his just debts be paid - from the ready money, if there be enough on hand. If not, from the personal property and the proceeds of the farm. The farm of eighty-five acres, he leaves to his widow Sarah Passon to use as her own during her lifetime and at her death to be divided among their children - Alice Foreman, Sarah Elizabeth Boze, Isabell Dotson, Hattie J. Wagoner, Ross Harden John and David Passon. The wife is named executrix and qualified as such.
