Funeral Here Today for Mrs. Mary Habegger  
Wife Of Andrew Habegger, 59, Dies

Mrs. Mary S. Habegger, 59, wife of Andrew Habegger of Berne R.R. 2, died at 9:00 a.m. Saturday in her home just east of Berne, along Highway 218. She had been ill since last March, had submitted to surgery and spent many weeks in the Adams County Memorial hospital. Death was attributed to cancer.

Services were held at 2 p.m. today at the Cross United Church of Christ, Rev. Robert L Hegnauer and Rev Gerald Stucky officiating. Burial was in the M.R.E. cemetery. The Yager Funeral home had charge of the service.

Mrs. Habegger was a native of Jay county, being born in Noble township January 20, 1907, a daughter of Charles and Molly Mast Myers. Her first husband, Peter Bailey, was killed in a traffic accident. On Nov. 21, 1956, she married Mr. Habegger.
