ISAAC BEER TAKEN BY DEATH

Retired Monroe Township Farmer Dies Thursday Afternoon

...ident of Adams county, died Thursday afternoon at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Jacob Kauffman, northwest of Berne. Death was caused by dropsey. He had been ill 10 days.

The deceased was born in Adams county, January 15, 1861, the son of Christian and Barbara Dubach-Beer. He married Caroline Fuchs at Berne in 1887 and she died in 1918.

Surviving besides the daughter are four sons, Albert and Wilbert Beer of Decatur and Edwin and Tillman Beer, northwest of Berne. Also surviving are a brother, C. C. Beer and a sister, Mrs. William Fuchs, both of Berne, 25 grandchildren and six great-grandchildren.

He was a member of the Cross Reformed church at Berne.

Funeral services will be at the Tillman Beer home at 1:30 p.m. Sunday and at 2 o'clock at the church, Rev. C. A. Schmid officiating. Burial will be in the M.R.E. cemetery at Berne. The body was removed from the Yager funeral home to the Tillman Beer residence this afternoon.
