Funeral Here Saturday for Prominent Local Woman, 79

Mrs. Rosa Beer, 79, of this city, widow of Harvey Beer, died Tuesday morning in Garfield Hospital, Monterey Park, California, following a massive heart attack. She had been ill four weeks or since October 6 when she was stricken with the first attack. Death occurred at 11:30 am Tuesday, Berne time, or 8:30 am California time.

Mrs. Beer and her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Ralph Beer, also of this city, left October 3 for California to visit Mr. and Mrs. Pat Raudenbush and Family. Mrs. Raudenbush is the granddaughter of Mrs. Beer. On October 6, Mrs. Beer was stricken and taken to the hospital where she spent several days in intensive care ward. She improved and was taken to a regular room. Last Friday she became worse, then showed improvement Saturday and Sunday and had a real good Monday and Monday night. Tuesday morning she suffered another attack and died almost instantly.

Mrs. Ralph Beer returned here a week ago when her mother-in-law appeared better. Ralph had returned earlier flying west to be with his mother after she was stricken. Her daughters, Mrs. Eugene Melchi and Mrs. Claire Sprunger, were at her bedside when she passed away.

Mrs. Beer was floor lady at the Nussbaum Novelty Company for 35 years before her retirement in March of 1967.

She was born in French Township February 24, 1889, a daughter of Mathias and Mary Ann Galli Liechty. Her husband preceded her in death on August 5, 1928.
