Matilda Christener is taken by death

Matilda I. Christener, 69, a native of Monroe Township, died at the Lutheran Hospital in Fort Wayne at 5:05 pm Saturday where she had been a patient since Nov. 30. Death was attributed to a cerebral hemorrhage and she had been seriously ill for ten days. Miss Christener resided at 3022 Weisser Park, Fort Wayne.

She formerly resided here and attended the Berne schools, moving to Fort Wayne 45 years ago. She was employed in the office of the Perfection Biscuit Company in Fort Wayne for many years.

Miss Christener was born December 28, 1897, a daughter of Gottlieb and Magdalena Stauffer Christener. She was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ in Fort Wayne.

Surviving are three brothers, William and Fred Christener, Monroe R.R. 1; and Albert, Standish, Michigan; five sisters, Ida and Rose Christener of Monroe, R.R. 1; Mrs. William (Caroline) Purvis, Tacoma Park, Maryland; Mrs. Dwight L. (Lavona) Purdy, Decatur and Mary Christener, Fort Wayne. Two brothers and two sisters preceded in death.
