Berne - 1910-2000

Alfred E. "Tuck" Clauser, 90, of Berne, a 37-year member of the Berne Volunteer Fire Department, died Sunday, May 14, 2000, at Adams County Memorial Hospital.

The Allentown, Pa., native was co-founder of Clauser Furniture, had worked at Dunbar Furniture Co. for 25 years, was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church where he held several offices and served on several boards, a former member of the Lions Club, Berne-French School Board, had served as chief of the fire department for a number of years and was a charter member of the Swiss Heritage Society.

Surviving are a son, Fred of Berne; a daughter, Madelyn Wurster of Berne; a brother, Myron of Berne; five grandchildren; and nine great-grandchildren.

His wife, Earlene H., preceded him in death on April 30.

Services are 10 a.m. Thursday at Trinity United Methodist Church, Berne, with calling one hour before services. Calling is also from 2 to 8 p.m. Wednesday at Swiss Village Chapel, Berne. Burial will be at MRE Cemetery, Berne.
