Calvin O. Dubach Taken by Death This Morning
Local Man, 74, Dies at Hospital; Rites Sunday

Calvin O. Dubach, 74, 411 Clark Street, died at 9:30 am today at the Adams County Memorial Hospital where he was admitted early this morning. He suffered a heart attack at his home during the night and was taken to the hospital by ambulance soon after midnight. Mr. Dubach had been in failing health but was not ill.

A retired mechanic, Mr. Dubach and his brother Roy, deceased, operated a garage in Linn Grove for many years. He was a lifelong resident of Adams County and he and his wife moved to Berne ten years ago from Hartford Township. He was a veteran of World War I, receiving a medical discharge.

Mr. Dubach was born in Adams County January 10, 1893, a son of Fred and Adina Gerber Dubach. He was married to Estella Fox on April 3, 1920.

Surviving are the wife; two sons, Glen Dubach, Geneva R.R. and Lester Dubach, Huntington; a daughter, Mrs. Max (Fern) Habegger, Fort Wayne; eight grandchildren and a brother, Elmer Dubach, Geneva, R.R. One grandchild, a brother, Roy and a sister, Mrs. Vilas Steiner are deceased.

Mr. Dubach was a member of the Cross United Church of Christ.

The body is at the Yager Funeral Home where friends may call after 1 pm Saturday and where services will be held at 2 pm Sunday. Rev. Robert L. Hegnauer will officiate at the service and burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.
