WIFE OF RAYMOND EICHER DIES TODAY

Funeral at Geneva on Monday for 42-Year-Old Woman

Mrs. Bonnie Mae Eicher, 42, wife of Raymond Eicher of Geneva R. R. 2, died at 5:45 a.m. today at the Adams County Memorial hospital. Death was attributed to chronic nephritis. Mrs. Eicher had been in failing health for some time and was admitted to the hospital Thursday morning. She had been in the hospital on a previous occasion.

A native of Kentucky, Mrs. Eicher was born Sept. 23, 1915, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Burdge Womack.
