Local Man, 55, is Found Dead This Morning

Services Here on Sunday for Harry Ellenberger

Harry Ellenberger, 55, a lifelong resident of this community, died at about 3 AM today in his trailer home at 524 Welty St. in the city. His lifeless body was found by his brother-in-law, Lester Farlow, who with his family lives in a house at the same address. Ellenberger rode to work with Farlow and was not ready to go to work at his usual time this morning. Farlow investigated and found Ellenberger dead, apparently the victim of a heart attack. He had not been ill.

Mr. Ellenberger had been employed at the Nussbaum Novelty Company for the last 38 years. He was a veteran of World War II. From 1943 - 46 and served in the South Pacific.

He was born in Monroe Township, January 22, 1913, the son of Henry H. and Elizabeth Moser Ellenberger.

He is survived by a brother, Arley Ellenberger, Geneva R. R. 2 and four sisters, Mrs. J. D. (Mabel) Gallagher, Dayton, O.; Mrs. Lester (Nima) Farlow, Berne; Mrs. Justus (Orpha) Augsburg, Berne and Mrs. Calvin R. (Helen) Adams, Berne. One sister preceded in infancy.

Mr. Ellenberger was a member of the First Mennonite Church.

The body is at the Yager Funeral Home, where friends may call after 4 PM Saturday. Services will be held there at 3 PM Sunday, with Rev. Gordon J. Neuenschwander officiating. Burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.
