Wilford Habegger Dies in California

Wilford Habegger, 65, a native of this community, died this morning in St. Joseph Hospital at Burbank, California, according to information received here by relatives. He resided in North Hollywood, California and had ailed for some time with a heart ailment. He entered the hospital Monday but had spent several weeks in the hospital some time ago. He was a mail clerk in a large industrial plant for many years but retired in July.

Mr. Habegger was born here June 30, 1903, a son of Louis and Dina Sprunger Habegger. He was married to Helen Barnett, who preceded in death. Later he married Wanda Harker who survives.

Also surviving are two daughters, Mrs. Lamar (Joan) Winteregg of Berne and Mrs. Harley (May) Campbell of near Bryant; five grandchildren; a brother, Rev.
