

MRS. D. D. JONES IS TAKEN BY DEATH

Mrs. Maggie Pearl Jones, 79, widow of Dr. D. D. Jones, prominent Berne physician, died at 4:30 o'clock Monday afternoon at the Adams county memorial hospital. She had been bedfast since August of last year.

She was born in Adams county, June 23, 1881, a daughter of William and Elizabeth Patterson-Rawley, and was married to D. D. Jones in 1911. Dr. Jones preceded her in death in 1953.

Mrs. Jones was a member of the Cross United Church of Christ in Berne and the American Legion Auxiliary.

Surviving are three sons, Robert L. Jones of Ontario, Calif.; Rawley Jones of Berne route 2, and Benjamin Jones of Atlanta, Ga.; five grandchildren; two great-grandchildren, and one sister, Miss Jessie Rawley of Geneva. One brother and two sisters are deceased.
