ELNORA LANGHAM 1920-2006

BERNE, Ind. - Elnora Langham, 85, of Berne, Ind., passed away at 10:30 p.m. Thursday, April 27, at Chalet Village in Berne.

She was born May 17, 1920 in Adams County, Ind., the daughter of Joseph and Magdalena (Hirschy) Cook. On Sept. 2, 1943, she married Harold "Breezy" Langham, who preceded her in death in 1990. She was a homemaker and had been employed at Berne Overall Co., later the Nussbaum Novelty Co., and was a former nurse's aide at Swiss Village. She was a member of First Missionary Church in Berne, and had been active in the church's ladies society, and had assisted her husband with Sunday School visitation.
