Wife of Omer D. Lehman Dies Early Today
Funeral Here Sunday PM for Local Woman, 82

Mrs. Celestine Lehman, 82, wife of Omer D. Lehman of this city, died in her sleep early this morning at the Lehman Home, 408 Clark Street. Mrs. Lehman had been in ill health for four years and an invalid for 14 months. Her condition had been serious the past few days and her lifeless body was found at 7 am today by her husband when he took breakfast to her.

Mr. and Mrs. Lehman had resided in Berne since 1943 when they moved here from the farm where Horace Lehman now resides. Earlier they resided farther east of Berne and were in the path of the 1920 tornado which wrecked their buildings.

Mrs. Lehman was born in Monroe Township April 30, 1887, a daughter of David and Elizabeth Winteregg Depp. She was married to Mr. Lehman May 18, 1913. She was a member of the First Mennonite Church.

Surviving in addition to the husband are a son, Willard Lehman of this city; three grandchildren and two sisters, Mrs. Gilbert (Minnie) Stucky of Berne and Mrs. Homer (Leona) Gibson of Pontiac, Michigan. A brother, David Depp and two sisters, Mrs. Vilas Schindler and Martha Depp preceded in death.

The body is at the Yager Funeral Home where friends may call after 2 o'clock pm Saturday.

Services will be held at 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the funeral home with Rev. Gordon Neuenschwander and Rev. Gerald Stucky officiating. Interment will be in the MRE Cemetery
