Harley Lehman, 87, Swiss Village, Berne, died at 3:25 p.m. Monday in the Adams County Memorial Hospital.

He was a retired Decatur businessman, formerly owning Decatur Super Service Pontiac Agency and Lehman Motors. Mr. Lehman was also a bus mechanic for North Adams Community Schools. He was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church. Mr. Lehman had been a resident of Swiss Village since 1991.

He was born in Adams County on July 14, 1906 to Burkhart and Lydia (Sprunger) Lehman. He married Lydia M. Sommer on June 6, 1935 in Berne. She survives.

Other survivors include two sons, Don Lehman of Decatur and Lynn F. Lehman of Noblesville; one daughter, Mrs. Herbert (Luanne) Pearce of Fairfax, Va.; a brother, Leslie Lehman of Berne; and six grandchildren.

Six brothers - Leo, Albert, Herman, Elmer, Harry and Reuben -preceeded him in death, as did three sisters, Viola Stettler, Molly Nuenschwander and Cora Nussbaum.
