Leming Rites Held Sunday

Mrs. Eve Cook Leming, 87, Died Here Friday Afternoon

Mrs. Eve Cook Leming, 87, passed away at her home on Railroad Street Friday afternoon shortly after 2 o'clock. Death was attributed to old age and she had been ill for the past three weeks. She would have been 88 years old had she lived until April 27.

The deceased was a stepmother of Mrs. Maude Abnet and an aunt of Mrs. Gid Riesen.

She was born southeast of Berne and was married to Jasper Leming who proceeded many years ago.

She was the last survivor of the family, three brothers, Grate, Jacob, George and two sisters, Mrs. Rebecca Smith and Mrs. Elizabeth Rumble having proceeded.

There were no children.

The funeral was held Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the First Missionary Church here, burial in the M.R.E. Cemetery.
