Aldine Liechty Taken by Death Sunday Morning

Funeral Tuesday for Widow of Former Jeweler, 84

Mrs. Aldine Liechty, 84, widow of the late Sam Liechty, former local jeweler, passed away at 9 o'clock Sunday morning at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. She had been in ill or in failing health for some time at her home and 766 West Water St. She had been bedfast for 10 days.

Mrs. Liechty was born on April 14, 1884 in Canton, Bern, Switzerland, the daughter of Anthony and Mary Burry Simon, but has been a resident of Berne since her infancy. She was married to Samuel Liechty on April 4, 1907. Mr. Liechty preceded her in death a number of years ago.

Surviving are the following children: Mrs. Albert (Ellen) Yoder of Berne; Dr. Ralph W. Liechty of Wooster, Ohio; Dr. Clinton S. Liechty of Loudenville, Ohio and Dr. Palmer E. Liechty of Fort Wayne. There are 16 grandchildren and 6 great-grandchildren. A brother, David Simon and a sister, Mrs. William Thompson, both of Berne, also survived.

Preceding her in death was a son, Elmer R., and the following brothers and sisters: Arnold, Joseph, Henry, Edward, Mrs. Henry Gerber and Mrs. Dan Gerber, Sr. and 3 in infancy.

Mrs. Liechty was a member of the First Mennonite Church.
