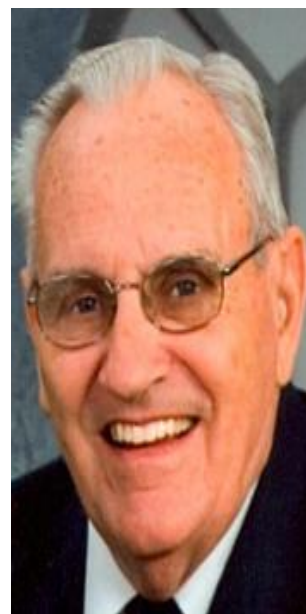


Harry W. Luginbill
