

C. A. Martz, 72, Retired Pennsy Conductor, Dies

Christian A. Martz, 72, 2715 John St., died yesterday at 2:20 p.m. in St. Joseph's Hospital, where he had been a patient three days. Mr. Martz had been bedfast about three weeks. Born and raised in Berne, he had lived in Fort Wayne the past 47 years. He retired five years ago after 44 years service as a conductor on the Pennsylvania Railroad.
