Rites Here Saturday for Herman Mathys

Herman Mathys, 66, a native of Berne, died at 10 am Wednesday in the Fort Wayne State Hospital and Training Center where he had resided since 1946. Death was attributed to coronary thrombosis and coronary arteriosclerosis.

He was born February 15, 1900, in Berne, a son of Frederick and Lydia Klopfenstein Mathys. His father formerly operated a brick yard in Berne, on the site where Dunbar Furniture now is located.

He is survived by two brothers, Wilbur Mathys, Muncie and Vernon Mathys, R.R. 2, Bluffton; four sisters, Mrs. Aldulla Hanni, Decatur; Mrs. John (Freda) Derrickson, Willard, Ohio; Mrs. Charles (Ora Mae) Weikel, Berne R.R. 1 and Mrs. Alice Marie Buckingham, Geneva, in addition to several nephews and nieces.

A brother, Clinton Mathys died in 1954.
