Homer Meshberger, 61, R.R. 2, Roanoke, died at 2 pm yesterday in Lutheran Hospital where he had been a patient since Nov. 22. He was a native of the Berne Community.

He operated an upholstery shop at his residence.

Mr. Meshberger was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Edward Meshberger. He was born on a farm in French Township where he spent his boyhood. While living in the Berne area, he was employed as an upholsterer at Smith Brothers Furniture Company. He moved to Roanoke about 25 years ago where he started his upholstery shop.

Survivors include his wife, Laura; two sons, S. Sgt. Wesley O. Meshberger, serving in Vietnam and Sherman L., of near Fort Wayne; two stepdaughters, Mrs. John Kavanaugh
