

WM. MILLER DIES AT HOME OF DAUGHTER

Former Berne Man Is Taken By Death

William Miller, 83, former Berne blacksmith, died Monday at the home of a daughter in Cleveland, O., according to word received here today. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

He had left Berne a number of years ago to reside with the daughter in Cleveland.
