David Moser, Retired Farmer Taken by Death

Funeral Here Thursday for Wabash Township Man, 72

David Moser, 72, retired Wabash Township farmer, residing on Geneva R.R. 1, died at 7:30 pm Monday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital where he had been a patient since January 12 when he suffered a stroke. His condition had been critical the past few days.

A lifelong resident of the community, Mr. Moser was born in French Township, September 28, 1895, a son of John J. J. and Josephine Kocher Moser. He was married September 28, 1922, in Berne to Edna Kneuss. She survives.

A daughter in infancy and two sisters, Mrs. Harve Neuenschwander and Mrs. Joe Meyer preceded in death.

Services will be held at 2:30 pm Thursday at the First Mennonite Church, of which he was a member, Rev. Gerald Stucky officiating. The body will be taken to the church at 1 pm. Burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.
