Widow of Edwin T. Moser Dies At 2 P.M. Sunday
Geneva Woman, 67, Succumbs in Jay County Hospital

Mrs. Elma Moser, 67, of Geneva, widow of Edwin T. Moser, died at 2 p.m. Sunday in Jay County hospital, Portland, where she had been a patient a few weeks. Death was attributed to a circulatory collapse. She was the former Elma Kneuss, and had been ill several months.

She was born near Geneva Sept. 10, 1898, a daughter of Abraham and Barbara Von Gunten Kneuss. She was married to Edwin T. Moser who died in November of 1962.
