**MOSER INFANT DIES NEAR GENEVA SAT.
BURIAL IS MADE AT M.R.E. CEMETERY WEST OF BERNE**

Philip Duane Moser, six-month-old son of Solomon Jr. and Lalita Blocher Moser, died Saturday morning at the home of his parents four miles west of Geneva. He had been ill two days with cerebral meningitis.

The child had apparently been in good health except for a slight cold but Thursday evening went into convulsions and suffered twenty-four hours of them before he passed away.

Surviving besides the parents are one brother, Jimmy, and the grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Sol Moser, and Mr. and Mrs. James Runyon, both of east of Geneva.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 this afternoon at the Apple Grove church with the Rev. Robert Rash of Zanesville officiating.

Burial was in the M.R.E. cemetery west of town.
