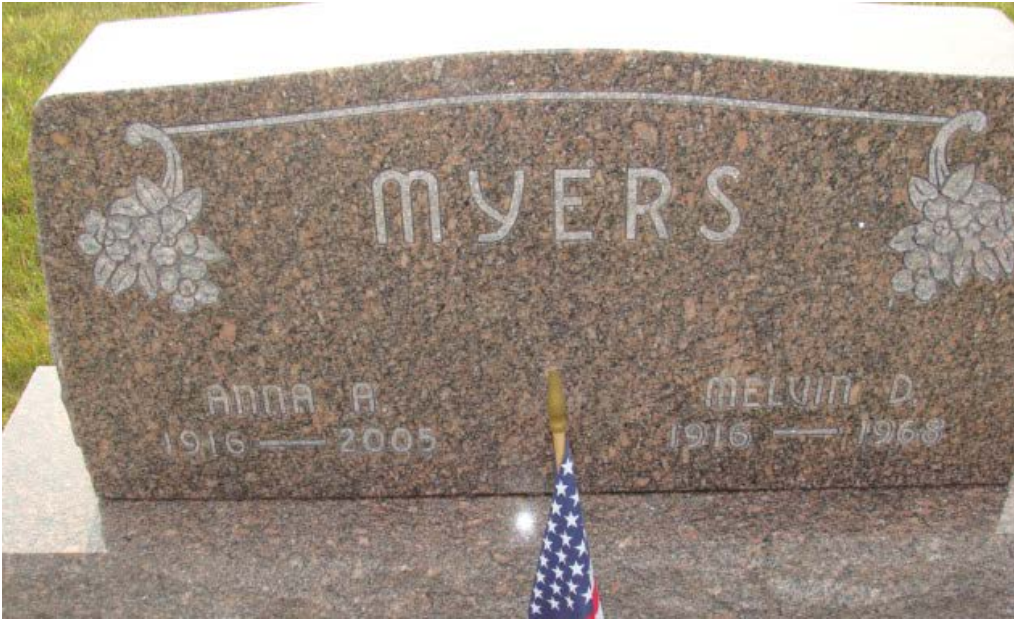

Melvin Myers Dies Suddenly This Morning  
Funeral Wednesday for Wabash Township Farmer, 52

Melvin Myers, 52, widely known Wabash Township farmer, died unexpectedly in his home at 7:30 am today. Death is blamed to a heart attack. Mr. Myers had suffered several previous attacks, but was up and around and had not been ill lately. Mr. Myers resided on Berne RR 2.

He was a lifelong resident of the community and was born March 11, 1916, a son of Glen and Elta Myers. He was married to Anna A. Liechty in 1938. Mrs. Myers is a sister to the late James Liechty who died recently.

Surviving in addition to the widow are a daughter, Mrs. Paul (Hope) Neal, Geneva; twin sons, True Myers, Geneva and Thomas Myers, Decatur; the mother, Mrs. Elta Myers, Berne; two brothers, John Robert Myers and William S. Myers, both of Berne R.R. 2 and a sister, Mrs. Samuel (Frieda) Yager, Berne R.R. 2.

Mr. Myers was a member of the Bethel Brethren Church east of Berne.

The body is at the Hardy and Hardy Funeral Home in Geneva where friends may call after 2 pm Tuesday. Services will be held at the funeral home at 2 pm Wednesday. Rev. Wayne Bantz, pastor of the Geneva Methodist Church will officiate.

The place of burial had not been determined this morning.
