

Calvin J. Nussbaum, 86, Berne, died at 12:40 a.m. Saturday at Swiss Village in Berne. A retired contractor, he was a former employee of Frank Nussbaum and Sons, owned Calvin Nussbaum Construction Company, and worked for the M. W. Habegger Company, the L. H. Carbide Company, and later with Hagerman Construction. He was a member of the First Mennonite Church of Berne, where he was a former Sunday School teacher, a member of the Men's Chorus, and a trustee. Born on August 19, 1917, in Adams County, Mr. Nussbaum was the son of Frank and Effie Fox Nussbaum and he was married on April 7, 1936, to Henrietta, who preceded him in death. Survivors include four daughters, Lynette Habegger of Fort Wayne; Mrs. Bud (Anita) Marble of Berne; Debbie Nussbaum of Indianapolis; and Mrs. Martin (Linda) MacDonald of Plano, Texas; two sisters, Mrs. Elmer (Vera) Graber of Berne, and Mrs. Katy Liechty of Berne; 13 grandchildren; and 23 great-grandchildren.
