Harold Walden Nussbaum, 89, resident of Berne, died Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at his residence. He was born on November 29, 1924 in Poneto, In. to Clifton and Louise L. (Lehman) Nussbaum. He married Marie Wiebe on July 26, 1969 in Watrous, Sask. Canada. She survives.
