Frederick T. Oliver, 56, of 266 Hoosier St., Berne, a self-employed truck owner and a driver for the Midwest Emery Truck Co., died at 1:15 a.m. today at the Fort Wayne Lutheran Hospital, following an illness of several months. Death was attributed to cancer.

Mr. Oliver was a veteran of World War II.

Born in Hartford Township on Jan. 22, 1922, he was the son of Walter and Pearl Strickler-Oliver; and was married in Bern on Feb. 24, 1946 to Marlene Townsend, who survives.
