## RITES SET THURSDAY FOR CRASH VICTIM

CELINA - Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at the First Missionary Church in Berne, Ind., for Mrs. Christine Louise Pfeffenberger, 21, Celina, who drowned here Sunday evening when the car driven by her husband, Alfred, skidded on Lake Shore Drive and upset into Grand Lake.

The car landed on its top in about four feet of water. The doors on the car were jammed by the accident and by the mud in the bottom of the channel. Pfeffenberger escaped through a door.

Surviving are her husband; her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Irvin Sprunger, Rt. 2, Geneva, Ind.; one sister, Mrs. Julia McCollough, Rt. 1, Monroe, Ind.; and one brother, Ted, of Geneva. She was a member of the First Missionary Church.

The Rev. Klopfenstein will be in charge of the services with burial in the M.R.E. Cemetery at Berne. Friends may call at the Vale Funeral Home here until 10 a.m. tomorrow when the body will be removed to the Yager Funeral Home in Berne where friends may call until the time of the rites.
