NICHOLAS RICH DIES SATURDAY

Prominent Monroe Township Farmer Dies Saturday Night

Nicholas Rich, 67, prominent farmer of Adams county, died at his home in Monroe township Saturday night at 9:45 o'clock of cancer. He had been bedfast for several weeks.

Mr. Rich had spent his entire life in this county and was a prominent farmer. He was a stockholder and director of the Peoples State Bank.

He was born in French township December 6, 1867, a son of Joseph and Anna Moser-Rich. He (sic) marriage to Elizabeth Dailey (sic) took place on April 26, 1894.

Surviving are the widow and two children, William Rich and Mrs. Rufus Nussbaum of Monroe township. Two brothers, John Rich of Berne and David Rich of Fort Wayne, and a sister, Mrs. Jonas Myers of Vera Cruz, also survive. One daughter, four brothers and two sisters preceded him in death.

He was a member of the Reformed church at Berne. Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock at the home and at 2 o'clock at the church. Rev. C. W. H. Sauerwein of Plymouth will officiate and burial will be in M. R. E. cemetery.
