Kendrick L. Roth, 81, Berne, died at 9:35 a.m. Wednesday in Lutheran Hospital, Fort Wayne. He was born in Fort Wayne on September 11, 1925, to Ruben and Florence Welty Roth. He married Elsie Stauffer on May 4, 1947; she died earlier this year.

He was a retired accounting employee at the Magnavox Corp. plants in Fort Wayne and Champaign, Illinois, and also worked for Ford Motor Corp. in Champaign as a leasing manager. He once received a Red Cross blood donor award in Urbana, Illinois. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and in the U.S. Army Reserve. Mr. Roth was a member of Twin City Bible Church in Urbana.
