Miss Elizabeth Schindler, 91, a resident of this community most of her life, died at 7 a.m. Sunday at the Berne Nursing home where she resided. She had been in failing health for several years.

A native of French township, Miss Schindler was born March 17, 1874, a daughter of David and Catherine Schlatter Schindler. She moved with her parents to Hesperia, Michigan where they resided for 15 years, then moved back to Berne.
