Wife of Vilas A. Schindler Dies Tuesday

Funeral Here Friday for Prominent Local Woman, 74

Mrs. Mary Schindler, 74, wife of Vilas A. Schindler of 305 Sprunger Street, died unexpectedly in her home at 4 pm Tuesday. Death is blamed to coronary thrombosis. She had not been well for a number of years, but was up and around until a few days ago. She had the flu several days ago. She also was afflicted quite severely with arthritis.

Mrs. Schindler was a lifelong resident of this community and widely known. She was born July 28, 1893, in Monroe Township, a daughter of David and Elizabeth Winteregg Depp. She was married to Mr. Schindler April 14, 1918.

Surviving in addition to the husband are a son, Dr. Robert S. Schindler, a medical missionary in Monroevia, Liberia, West Africa, who, with his family, returned to his work recently after spending a furlough in the states; two daughters, Mrs. Lewis G. (Betty) Habegger, South Bend and Mrs. Howard M. (Gyneth) Luginbill, Indianapolis; nine grandchildren and three sisters, Mrs. Omar (Celestine) Lehman, and Mrs. Gilbert (Wilhelmina) Stucky, both of Berne and Mrs. Homer (Leona) Gibson, Pontiac, Michigan.

A brother, David D. Depp and a sister, Martha, preceded in death.

Mrs. Schindler was an active member of the First Missionary Church, where services will be held at 10 am Friday, Rev. Gerald Gerig and Rev. C. H. Wiederkehr will officiate and burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.
