Samuel Schindler dies late Tuesday

Samuel Schindler, 85, a resident of the Berne Nursing Home for 13 years, died Tuesday at 7:00 pm of cardiac failure. He had been seriously ill the last few days.

Mr. Schindler was born July 29, 1882 in French Township to David and Elizabeth Schlatter Schindler, both deceased. He lived most of his life in this county and worked as an upholsterer with Smith Brothers Furniture Co. for twenty years.
