Prominent Retired Farmer Died Saturday

Edwin Schlagenhauf, 91, the prominent farmer of Bluffton, R. 3, West of Berne, died at the Swiss Village Nursing Care unit at 2:48 PM Saturday after a nine-month illness. The cause of death was a cerebral hemorrhage.

He was the son of John and Lutica Gentis Schlagenhauf and was born in Harrison Township, Wells County, on January 21, 1878.

His marriage to Luetta Liddy, who preceded, was on February 9, 1900, in Linn Grove.
