Wife of John Soldner Dies Last Evening

Funeral Here Sunday for Monroe Township Woman, 76

Mrs. John (Sarah) Soldner, 76, of route 1, Berne, Monroe Township, who had been living at the Berne Nursing Home for the past two years, died at 5:05, Thursday afternoon at the Adams County Memorial Hospital. Death was attributed to complications. She had been sick for the past three and a half years.

Mrs. Soldner, who was a lifetime resident of Adams County, was born a daughter of Fred and Magdalena Treuhardt Zurcher on May 10, 1890. She was married to John Soldner in Berne on April 16, 1912.
