Local Woman, 74, Dies in Adams County Hospital

Miss Alina Sprunger, 74, a lifelong resident of this community, died at 8:15 pm Monday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital where she had been a patient five weeks. She had been ailing since last October. Miss Sprunger resided at 506 West Franklin Street. She was employed for 30 years at the former Winner House here.

Miss Sprunger was born July 3, 1893, a daughter of Frederick and Katherine Sprunger Sprunger. She was a member of the First Mennonite Church.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. John (Bertha) Kauffman, Freeman, South Dakota and Milka Sprunger of 506 West Franklin and who resided with her sister.

Three brothers and five sisters preceded in death. They are Daniel, Otto, Ira, Mary Ann, Hannah, Mrs. Gideon (Emma) Sprunger, Mrs. Noah (Dina) Habegger and Rose.
