Miss Anna C. Sprunger, 57, Dies Tuesday

Services Thursday for Widely Known Local Woman

Miss Anna C. Sprunger, 57, 712 West Wabash Street, died at 1:55 am Tuesday at the Adams County Memorial Hospital following an illness of six days. Death was attributed to a massive cerebral hemorrhage which she suffered in her home.

Miss Sprunger was semi-retired. For 30 years, she was employed as a secretary for Moser Motor Sales. For many years, she managed a catering service, specializing in wedding receptions and became widely known throughout the community. She was a lifelong resident of Berne.

A native of Berne, Miss Sprunger was born August 11, 1911, a daughter of Levi A. and Mathilda Baumgartner Sprunger.

Surviving are two sisters, Mrs. E. J. (Alina) Neuenschwander of Berne and Mrs. Harry D. (Lydia) McCreery, Battle Creek, Michigan. Two brothers, Grover and Harry Sprunger and a sister, Mrs. Leona Liechty, preceded in death.

Miss Sprunger was a member of the First Mennonite Church where services will be held at 1:30 pm Thursday. Rev. Gordon Neuenschwander will officiate and burial will be in the MRE Cemetery.
